Every year, up to four million people in Australia – 18% of the population – regularly experience food insecurities. All year round, Foodbank works hard to change this and alleviate hunger throughout Australia. Working in partnership with BHP, the not-for-profit organisation provides more than 70% of the food for relief organisations nation-wide: a massive and very important contribution which actively ensures people and families don't go hungry.

On Tuesday 28 June, a small but mighty team of four volunteers from BHP's NPI Engineering Team volunteered their day by assisting Foodbank in the warehouse. The team were tasked with packing meat packs in the freezer room. These packs would then be sold within Foodbank agency space or distributed throughout the various Foodbank hubs. As the day wrapped up, the team had successfully packed over 300 meat packs, with the packs having a variety of options including beef, chicken, pork and some frozen onions or broccoli.
