Little Things for Tiny Tots (LTFTT) is a 100% volunteer run charity, providing new and pre-loved essential baby items to WA families in need. They create New Baby Boxes filled with 'little things' to assist families care for their newborn such as nappies, wipes, clothing, blankets, and books. They distribute New Baby Boxes via their partners including non-profit support services, hospitals, and government agencies. They are committed to providing help and support for babies and their families in their time of need.

On Thursday, the 1st of December, nine awesome volunteers from the Southflank FP Planning and Scheduling team dedicated their day to help sort and package donated baby items received from the community. The team got into the arts and crafts zone and put together old cardboard boxes originally containing nappies, soap, baby clothing and other donated items. The purpose of turning the boxes inside out was to remove the old labelling on the exterior of the box to make it more aesthetically pleasing, but most importantly – to recycle! Once each box was filled, it was then completed with a 'new baby box' sticker and packed with all the essentials. Each box consisted of items for new parents and guardians of newborn babies such as nappies, wet wipes, nappy cream, small toys and breast pumps – just to name a few!
