Every year, up to 4 million people in Australia, 18% of the population, regularly experience food insecurity. All year round, Foodbank works hard to change this and alleviate food hunger throughout Australia. Foodbank is the largest provider of vital food and groceries to food relief charities around Australia. Foodbank distributes its food and groceries to over 2,400 charities nationally, the majority of whom rank Foodbank as their organisation's most important source of food.

On the 1st of December, six volunteers from BHP's Learning Hub-Team spent their day at Foodbank. At the start of the day, the team was split into two groups. Team A was sent to the kitchen to prepare and chop green beans. This meant discarding the ends and chopping them into smaller bite-sized pieces. Team B was instructed to work in the warehouse packing pantry hampers. The hamper consisted of ritz crackers, canned spaghetti, pasta sauce, baked beans, pasta, and rice. The total cost of this hamper is \$8 (what a bargain). The team then moved on to packing fruit boxes which included apples and bananas. These fruit boxes would later be sent to schools to feed children for their breakfast programs.
