


HARD WORKING HELPERS

They do this by providing practical support to people, such as home maintenance, gardening, transport, and social community participation. People Who care employ gardeners who visit their client's homes once a month for 1 hour. Many of their client's homes require more work to be done than what can be achieved in the 1 hour visits so they rely heavily on the assistance of corporate volunteers.
