BHP AT FOODBANK

Foodbank is Australia's largest food relief organisation, operating on a scale that makes it crucial to the work of the front-line charities who are feeding vulnerable Australians. Foodbank provides more than 70% of the food rescued for food relief organisations nation-wide. Foodbank is a not-for-profit, non-denominational, federated organisation operating in every state and territory in Australia. Foodbank Australia is the only Australian food relief organisation that is a certified member of The Global Food Banking Network (GFN), comprised of 32 member countries, 19 of which are accredited.

On October 18, 2022, a team of four volunteers from BHP, took on the task of working alongside Chef Grant, in preparing meals to be distributed for Foodbank. After the induction, the team had to prepare sausages, curry sauce and rice with an addition of ribs. With help from the "Mushroom Guys", the 12 boxes of assorted donated mushrooms were used to make the sauce. By the end of the day, the team had prepared 300kg of sausages, 200L of sauce and 60kg of ribs.

It was an amazing effort by everyone on the day, and Foodbanks is grateful to the team for their excellent contribution. Well done team!
