## BACKYARD BLITZ WITH PEOPLE WHO CARE

People Who Care is a volunteer-based not for profit organisation that has been serving the community for over 40 years. Offering services and support for those who are frail aged, those with a disability and families starting over following domestic violence and disruption. Their vision is to build resilient communities through the engagement of willing volunteers, helping others in need. They do this by providing practical support to people, such as home maintenance, gardening, transport, and social and community participation. People Who care employ gardeners who visit their client's homes once a month for 1 hour. Many of their client's homes require more work to be done than what can be achieved in the 1-hour visits, so they rely heavily on the assistance of corporate volunteers.

On Friday, 30 September, the Nickel West Technology team travelled to sunny Darlington to tend to a large property owned by an elderly gentleman named Bernie. Bernie is a People Who Care Client who requires regular gardening support due to the size of the property.
