BUILDING BIKES!

Dismantle uses bikes as a tool to empower young people through their multiple programs.

On Friday 4 June, a group of 9 volunteers from the R&W team volunteered their valuable time to assist Dismantle with the ongoing task of sorting their workshop, stripping bikes for spare useable parts and fixing bikes already assembled. To kick start the day, the team were given an overview from Georgina, Volunteer Coordinator at Dismantle, of the work of the organisation and the tasks they would be undertaking. It was then all systems go, with the team starting the day by filling up a skip bin with old bike parts, and then helping reorganise the workshop areas. After smashing through this task, the team were then able to get into pairs, and pick a bike to strip for spare parts, which included bells, lights, seats, breaks etc. The sorted spare parts will then be used in the Dismantle Bike Rescue program to replace broken or missing parts on the participant's bikes. The team made a huge impact during their time, leaving Dismantle with both a clean and organised workshop, as well as sorting through a huge pile of bikes.
