WHEELIE WONDERFUL!

Dismantle is a non-for-profit that exists to provide young people with enabling support so they can manage their life in a self-directed way. Dismantle uses bikes as a tool to empower young people through their multiple programs, including their Bike Rescue program and ReNew Property Maintenance. Dismantle also provides ongoing training, equipment, guidance and support to regional partners to ensure sustainability and impact for young people and their communities.

On Friday 15 October, a group of volunteers from the NPI HV & Power team volunteered their valuable time to assist Dismantle with the ongoing task of sorting their workshop. To kick start the day, the team were given an overview from Georgina, Volunteer Coordinator at Dismantle, of the work of the organisation and the tasks they would be undertaking. It was then all systems go, with the team asked to utilise their organisational skills by doing a full audit of Dismantle's spare bike wheels, deciding whether the bike wheel is in good condition, finding the correct size tubbing and tyre, and then putting it together and placing it back onto the rack in an organised fashion. Any damaged or worn parts of the tyre were put into the skip bins at the back of the workshop – ensuring that everything on the racks were in good workable condition.

The sorted and fixed wheels will then be used in the Dismantle Bike Rescue program to replace broken or missing parts on the participant's bikes. The team made a huge impact during their time, leaving Dismantle with both a clean and organised workshop, as well as sorting through a huge pile of wheels.
