Little Things for Tiny Tots (LTFTT) is a 100% volunteer run charity, providing new and pre-loved essential baby items to WA families in need. They create New Baby Boxes filled with 'little things' to assist families care for their newborn such as nappies, wipes, clothing, blankets and books. They distribute New Baby Boxes via their partners including non-profit support services, hospitals and government agencies. They are committed to providing help and support for babies and their families in their time of need.

On Thursday 23 September, a group of volunteers from the Reliability Engineering/NPI/Iron Ore Team joined LTFTT at the Tuart Hill Community Centre for a day of sorting donations. The team were welcomed by LTFTT Volunteers Lori and Jackie, who talked about the work of the organisation and the number of baby boxes they have been able to distribute out to the community.

Then it was all systems go, with team members splitting into stations of different activities, including sorting donations of neutral clothing of sizes 000 and 0000, and then adding them into piles of type (jacket, onesies, pants etc.), ribbon cutting, box making, and writing personal congratulations cards to the new parent/s. After morning tea, the team were able to create some of the baby boxes, adding in the sorted clothing, along with a sleeping suit, blanket, toy, bag with diapers / wet wipes etc. and the hand written card.

As the day wrapped up, the team had created over 25 completed baby boxes, as well as sorting through a large stockpile of donations. It was a productive, rewarding and enjoyable volunteering day.
