

TERRIFIC TEAMWORK

Foodbank WA was established in 1994 and helps to feed more than 40,000 people every month. Foodbank is Australia's largest food relief organisation, operating on a scale that makes it crucial to the work of the front line charities who are feeding vulnerable Australians. Foodbank provides more than 70% of the food rescued for food relief organisations nation-wide.

On Friday 17 June, a group of 9 from the BOS PMO team arrived at Foodbank for a day volunteering in their warehouse. The team were split across two sides of the warehouse sorting area, with one side tasked with packaging up Pantry Staple Hampers including cereal, pasta, canned vegetables, noodles, long life milk and sauce, and the other side packaging up Breakfast {acks, including cereal, fruit cups, muesli bars and long life milk. Both teams got to work and quickly established fast moving production lines, and with some great comradery and teamwork throughout the day, the teams were able to complete 10 pallets of Pantry Hampers and 5 Crates of Breakfast packs – an incredible effort! All in all, it was a very productive day with an awesome team! Well done BOS PMO!
