WEEDING WIZARDS AT WORK

Friends of Cadogan Park is a natural areas volunteer group who work in the City of Joondalup. Their aim is to promote community awareness of local bush sites, and promote and participate in the conservation, rehabilitation, and protection of Cadogan Park and surrounding areas, to ensure long-term environmental sustainability and compatible human use.

On Wednesday 25 May, a team of volunteers from NPI Engineering dedicated their day in assisting with various activities at Cadogan Park in Kingsley. After an introduction from Jan and Caroline, the team put on their gloves, collected the tools, and was ready to get straight to work. Jan and Caroline took turns demonstrating how to plant the native seedlings, and then the team followed instructions and started planting in the middle of the park and along the fence line. The aim of the planting project is to restore, rehabilitate, and prevent weeds from investing in the area. By morning tea, all the plants were in the ground, and the team moved on to weeding the area for the rest of the day - working their way across the park, using the motto 'if in doubt, pull it out'. In the afternoon, Jan gave the team a walk and tour of the park, with the team learning about the history of the land and various native and non native plants.
