Foodbank's mission believes everyone should have access to good quality food which is why they aim to help the everyday Australians who are going without. With the rising cost of living, over 2 million households in Australia (21%) have experienced severe food insecurity in the last 12 months. They are a not-for-profit organisation operating in every state and territory in Australia, providing almost 7.8 million meals to Western Australians in 2022. And as Australia's largest food relief organisation, Foodbank work with 2,950 frontline charities and 2,890 school breakfast programs every year to get over 87.9 million meals out to those who could use a hand.

On Thursday 8 June, the NPI Reliability team got together for a day of donation sorting and hamper packing at the Foodbank WA warehouse located at Perth Airport. Upon arrival the team was given a quick briefing before putting on their high-vis vests and got straight to work. The team had a competitive streak, split into two teams and set themselves the target of 1,000 hampers for the day. The team managed to complete a massive 835 hampers all together. Team 1 completed 354 essential pantry hampers which included pasta, rice, pasta sauce and canned beans. Team 2 completed 418 tuna hampers which included tuna, ramen noodles and mayonnaise. After lunch the team finished off the day sorting through apples and pears making fruit boxes for Foodbanks school breakfast program.
