The Kalgoorlie Boulder Community Garden is a place where community members come together to grow fresh food, to learn, relax and make new friends. People from the community regularly attend sustainability workshops in composting, worm farming, grafting, propagation. Many students of all ages spend time at the garden including pre-primary through to tertiary students. The garden is also visited by seniors and other community groups such as migrant and mental health groups, creating an inclusive environment. Excess produce from the garden is provided to Kalgoorlie's Foodbank branch, the Women's Refuge and the Youth Hostel.

On Monday, 12 June 2023, 13 volunteers from the Kalgoorlie Lead Team got together for a day of site maintenance at the Kalgoorlie Boulder Community Garden. On arrival the team was greeted by the lovely Lillian, the community garden secretary who took the team through the tasks for the day. The team divided and conquered and got straight to work. The team smashed through the tasks at hand, including digging a small trench for the new Chicken Coop. This trench will be used for new pipes and water access for the chicken coop and for the surrounding areas. Other tasks from the day included building outdoor furniture and building a chicken climbing frame!
