## GOAL SHOOTERS AND DAY MAKERS

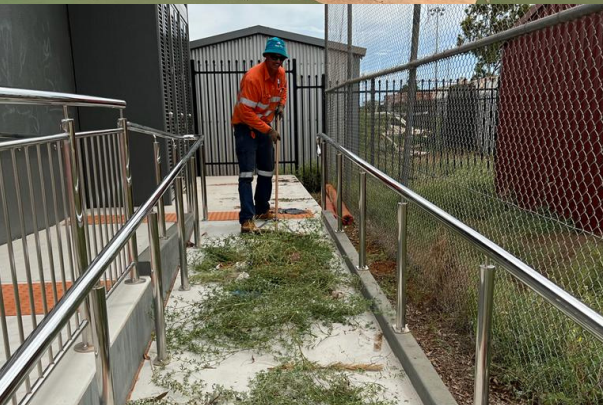
