



ONE SEEDLING AT A TIME!

Woodvale Waters Friends of Beenyup Channel is a dedicated community group operating within DBCA managed zones within Yellagonga Regional Park. Focused on the restoration and re-greening of the channel and its surrounding environs connecting Beenyup Swamp to the southern extremity of Lake Joondalup, their primary mission is rehabilitation. The group actively engages volunteers in various facets of their initiatives, emphasising tasks such as the removal of nonnative plants, collaborative planting days, and the continual fulfillment of watering needs to foster sustainable growth.

On a warm Wednesday, November 22, the Perth HR team united for an afternoon dedicated to the rehabilitation and revegetation of the area surrounding the channel connecting to Beenyup Swamp. Bryan and Jan warmly welcomed the team, providing a comprehensive introduction and detailed demonstrations on the tasks ahead—digging holes, fertilising, and planting each seedling. The mission was clear: restore, rehabilitate, and thwart the encroachment of weeds in the region. The team, put on their gloves, dispersed across different areas and swiftly got down to the task at hand.

As the day drew to a close, the collective efforts of the team resulted in the successful planting of over 200 vegetation units, accompanied by a substantial contribution to weeding activities, fostering the survival of neighboring trees.
