SORTING LEGENDS

Little Things for Tiny Tots, a non-profit organisation run completely by volunteers, provides necessary infant products, including both new and lightly used items, to families in need in WA. They put together New Baby Boxes containing essential items like diapers, wipes, clothing, blankets, and books, with the goal of assisting families in nurturing their infants. These New Baby Boxes are distributed through their partner organisations, which consist of non-profit support services, women's shelters, hospitals, and government agencies.

On Thursday, November 9, the Perth HR Consulting team convened at the Stirling Community Centre to aid in organising donations for Little Things for Tiny Tots. Upon arrival, Volunteer Coordinator Laura greeted the team and presented an overview of the organisation, explaining the day's tasks.

The team split into smaller groups to efficiently handle various responsibilities, including sorting donations into different categories, assembling, and disassembling boxes, preparing swaddle bundles, and creating baby boxes. These baby boxes were categorised as female, male, or neutral and included a variety of clothing items, accessories, blankets, a handwritten card, and an arm-free sleep suit. The team efficiently completed their tasks, managing to pack 8 female, 14 male, and 21 neutral baby boxes!
