IT'S THE LITTLE THINGS THAT MATTER

Little Things for Tiny Tots, a charity entirely operated by volunteers, offers essential baby items, both new and gently used, to families in need in WA. They assemble New Baby Boxes comprising fundamental necessities like diapers, wipes, clothes, blankets, and books, aiming to support families in caring for their newborns. These New Baby Boxes are distributed through their partner organizations, which include non-profit support services, women's refuges, hospitals, and government agencies.

On Wednesday, October 18, six committed volunteers from the Strategy Packers team assembled at the Stirling Community Centre to assist with donation organisation for Little Things for Tiny Tots. Upon arrival, Volunteer Coordinator Laura welcomed the team and provided an overview of the organization, outlining the day's tasks. Divided into two groups, the team undertook various responsibilities, including arranging bundles of ten baby girl outfits, assembling baby boxes containing essentials like diapers, wipes, toys, toiletries, books, and other newborn necessities, and writing cards. The day was filled with laughter, and the team exhibited exceptional teamwork. The team successfully managed to pack 51 new baby boxes and over 30 baby girl outfit bundles!
