Dismantle is a non-for-profit that exists to provide young people with enabling support so they can manage their life in a self-directed way. Dismantle uses bikes as a tool to empower young people through their multiple programs, including their Bike Rescue program and ReNew Property Maintenance. Dismantle also provides ongoing training, equipment, guidance and support to regional partners to ensure sustainability and impact for young people and their communities.

On Tuesday 18 January, a group of ten volunteers from BHP's WAIO Mining Systems FMS - Central Team volunteered their valuable time to assist Dismantle with the ongoing task of sorting their workshop. To kick start the day, the team were given an overview from Georgina, Volunteer Coordinator at Dismantle, of the work of the organisation and the tasks they would be undertaking. It was then all systems go, with the team starting off the day with organising and processing bike parts such as tubes, whilst moving furniture in the workshop. Three team members helped clean and organise Dismantle's kitchen. After lunch, the team had the opportunity to work on bikes, stripping spare parts that could be re-used. Any sorted spare parts will be used for Dismantle's BikeRescue program to replace broken or missing parts on the participant's bikes.
