Every year, up to four million people in Australia - 18% of the population - regularly experience food insecurities. All year round, Foodbank works hard to change this and alleviate hunger throughout Australia. Working in partnership with BHP, the not-for-profit organisation provides more than 70% of the food for relief organisations nation-wide: a massive and very important contribution which actively ensures people and families don't go hungry.

On December 9, six volunteers from BHP's PC&P Port and Rail Team dedicated their valuable time to volunteer in the freezer room at Foodbank. The day started off with a tour of the warehouse and shop by one of Foodbank's regular volunteers, Fiona. The tour helped the team understand Foodbank's operations and who can access the services. Each pack was valued at \$15, which included a variety of meat such as chicken, turkey, beef, lamb, vegetables and much more. During the session, the CEO of Foodbank, Kate and Partnerships Manager, Andrew came to the freezer room to express their gratitude to the team and acknowledge Foodbank's partnership with BHP. Before wrapping up, the team managed to pack 415 meat packs, which will be distributed at the shop. Foodbank greatly appreciated the team's help and assistance.
