Kanyana Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre is a not-for-profit organisation committed to the protection and welfare of native animals. Since its inception, the centre has more than doubled in capacity to meet the rehabilitation needs of wildlife admitted from the local community and around the state. Approximately 2000 animals representing 150 species are admitted annually with figures continuing to increase.

On June 10, nineteen enthusiastic volunteers from BHP's IPRO-SPRPA Team dedicated their Thursday to assist Kanyana. The team worked on general maintenance and gardening activities, including pruning plants, placing browse in animal enclosures, weeding, creating and re-routing a drainage, and digging sand into wheelbarrows. During their time at Kanyana, the team had the opportunity to see some wildlife, such as bilbies, possums and birds.
