## ONE WITH NATURE

Armadale Gosnells Landcare Group (AGLG) is a community led group that coordinates landcare planning, river restoration, bushland management, community action and community awareness programs. With the help of thousands of volunteers each year, AGLG focuses on implementing on-ground restoration and revegetation projects as well as educating the community about local Landcare issues. These on-ground activities mainly involve planting native seedlings (trees, shrubs, herbs, sedges and rushes) and removing priority environmental weeds.

On the first day of November, a group of eleven volunteers from BHP's BOS / IPRO Team contributed their Monday to assist AGLG at Mary Carroll Park in Gosnells. The team were tasked to plant local and native species along the river park to create a healthy wetland ecosystem and provide a wildlife habitat. Before the team got started with the activity, everyone wore waders and a pair of gumboots. Collecting a bucket of plants, the team divided into several groups and worked on different areas of the wetland. Some team members were brave to go further out into the waters to plant sedges. As the day wrapped up, the team planted over 1370 local species, which is a terrific end-result. Well done to this team for making a significant impact to the environment!
